Posters will be displayed for the duration of the conference. The poster session will take place during the opening reception on Thursday, February 1, from 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm.

Specifications

- Maximum dimensions: 45 x 45 inches
- Print on paper that is light enough to be pinned to poster panels with T-pins (pins and poster panels will be provided)
- Font size/type should be clearly legible from at least 2 feet away
- Posters should clearly state title, authors, and author contact information
- Presenters are encouraged to emphasize the conservation implications of their project in the poster's conclusion section

Poster Set Up

- Set up will take place Thursday morning, February 1, before the opening plenary or during subsequent breaks in the program schedule
- All posters must be set by 1:00 PM on February 1
- Poster panels will be numbered, please hang your poster on the board that corresponds with your abstract number

Conference Poster Session

- Please be available at your poster to present and answer questions during the poster session, which will take place during the opening reception, 5:30 pm – 7:00 pm on February 1

Poster Break Down

- Break down will take place during breaks on Saturday afternoon, February 3

Student Poster Awards

- 5 prizes of \$200 each will be awarded to the best student posters – sign up ahead of time to be eligible for the contest by contacting Nick Jensen, njensen@rsabg.org.
